

SHEEP Check-in Information

All animals will go through a health screening by a member of the sheep health committee PRIOR to being placed in the barn. Scrapie tags must be in place at this time. Check-in times are as follows:

Saturday prior to fair – 4:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m.

Sunday prior to fair – 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

If an animal is found to be in poor health or a potential risk to other livestock, exhibitors, or the public it will be held in an inspection pen until the sheep health committee has a chance to evaluate the animal and come to a conclusion.

A member of the committee will be present at all check-in times to evaluate the animals before they are unloaded from trailers and put in pens. We would ask that you would please not unload any sheep before they are checked. We have given a large window of time for this to make it work well. We strongly encourage leaders and exhibitors to be aware of the health of all the animals in their club so as not to bring sick animals to the fair.
