Camping Rules and Regulations

- A. Limited to active exhibitors and their families.
- B. The Fair Board discourages exhibitors, who live within a reasonable distance & can easily commute each day, from staying overnight
- C. Exhibitors must have parents permission and be adequately chaperoned by leaders if staying in the campground. Chaperones must be age 21 or older.
- D. Exhibitors must be in their sleeping quarters, lights out and silence at 11:00 pm. Monday Through Thursday. Curfew on Friday is 12:00 AM.
- E. Campers 30' or longer must park their car in the parking lot. (parking pass required.)
- F. Campers less than 30' are allowed ONE car only in the campground. (parking pass required.)
- G. Golf Carts, ATV's, and etc., are only allowed for Superintendents and one Per club camping south of the trees. These must be registered at Guest Services.
- H. Generators will be allowed to run between 7:00 AM. And 11:00 PM. Only
- I. No dogs allowed except for service dogs and dogs registered for show at this Fair.
- J. A list of tenants and their lot number MUST be turned into the Fairgrounds Guest Services Office no later than Monday of Fair Week. You will be given the lot numbers for each tenant to post on their camper. This is to help with locating the tenants in the event of an emergency or for having their campers pumped.
- K. Campsites are for sleeping quarters only. Not for storage trailers or parking cars.
- L. No Bicycles will be allowed!!! No Exceptions!
- M. No open fires are permitted in accordance with Lowell City ordinance (Ord. No. 88-11, 1a, 5-16-88) (Section 10-41).
- N. No Fireworks are allowed.
- O. Keep all drives clear for emergency vehicle access.
- P. Exhibitors will be sent home if they do not comply with rules and regulations.
- Q. Camping disputes will be settled by the Campground Chairman. His/Her decision will be final.
